


Another Unique Industry

Data flow and data modelling techniques that work in other industries have failed to deliver business benefits in E&P companies:




Naïve View

So... what does E&P experience teach?

- Document reality, then identify opportunities
- Data categories not Data types
 - Avoid "data modelling" (the POSC lesson)
 - Apply systematically
- Repositories not Applications (and especially not Databases)
- Use generic EA terms if possible, but be aware where specialised variations are needed:
 - Profiles, Maturity, Roles, Function, Asset Lifecycle, Activities,
 Data Conventions, Data Ownership, Data Lifecycle


Simpler, more comprehensive (but less familiar) picture










Repository roles - Well Data




Repository roles - Curve Data







The "IM Landscape"








Typical Maturity breakdown




Maturity v Complexity






Data Management International



The DMBoK Functions








